HOW TO UNINSTALL REPUTE 2.5

To uninstall Repute 2.5 using Windows' Installer:

1. On the computer where Repute is installed, right-click on Windows' Start button and select Setting
2. On Windows 11:
 - 2.1. Select Apps > Installed apps and wait for the display to refresh
 - 2.2. Scroll down the list of apps until you find Repute 2.5
 - 2.3. Click the ... button on the right-hand side of the display and select Uninstall
 - 2.4. A message "This app and its related info will be uninstalled" will appear
 - 2.5. Click Uninstall again to confirm
3. On Windows 10:
 - 3.1. Select Apps and wait for the display to refresh
 - 3.2. Scroll down the list of apps until you find Repute 2.5
 - 3.3. Click on Repute 2.5 and select Uninstall
 - 3.4. A message "This app and its related info will be uninstalled" will appear
 - 3.5. Click Uninstall again to confirm

To manually uninstall Repute 2.5:

1. Open Windows' File Explorer
2. To delete Repute's program files:
 - 2.1. Navigate to the folder C:\Program Files (x86)\Geocentrix\Repute
 - 2.2. Right-click on the folder "2.5" and select Delete*
3. To delete Repute's program data:
 - 3.1. Navigate to the folder C:\ProgramData\Geocentrix\Repute
 - 3.2. Right-click on the folder "2.5" and select Delete*
4. To delete Repute's documents:
 - 4.1. Navigate to the folder C:\Users\Public\Documents\Geocentrix\Repute
 - 4.2. Right-click on the folder "2.5" and select Delete*
5. Repute does not store any information in Windows' Registry, so there is no need to edit that

*Depending on your security clearance, you might be prompted to enter your credentials to perform the deletion
